Hard Ware

- Vendor and vendee can

- ① Weigh it
- ② Bite it
- ③ Throb it
- ④ ...

→ both are able to check the ware

- Rights of the vendee

- ① Ownership
- ② Alteration
- ③ Sale

- Duplication not worth the effort

Soft Ware

- Is it really ware?
 - ① Weight?
 - ② Checkable?
 - ③ ...
- Rights of the buyer of the license
 - ① Right to use
 - ② No changes
 - ③ No selling
- Duplication prevented by technical means

Fresh fish



- Market: vendee and vendor able to evaluate ware
- Does soft ware stink?
- No pain, no gain.

Soft ware is not for sale

- Free of charge: Going once, going twice ... BANG
 - ① *Download here* → “free beer”
 - ② See everything, hear everything - but say nothing
 - ③ Free Software
- Where's the catch?

The catch: Free \neq free of charge

- Crucial: free usage of the code
 - Free in the sense: “free speech”
 - Free speech requires
 - Time to prepare
 - Competence
 - Sometimes courage
- costs
- Exact definition: Debian Free Software Guidelines

As You Like it

- Long term continuous functionality
- Egal, welches Programm Funktionalität bereitstellt
- $\text{Functionality} = \text{Program} + \text{Service}$
- Reasonable amount of cost is acceptable
- Program free of charge \longrightarrow more money for service left
- Open sources \longrightarrow kostenlose Mitarbeiter
- Quality increases with the number of users ...
- ... , who have understand the principle and report bugs

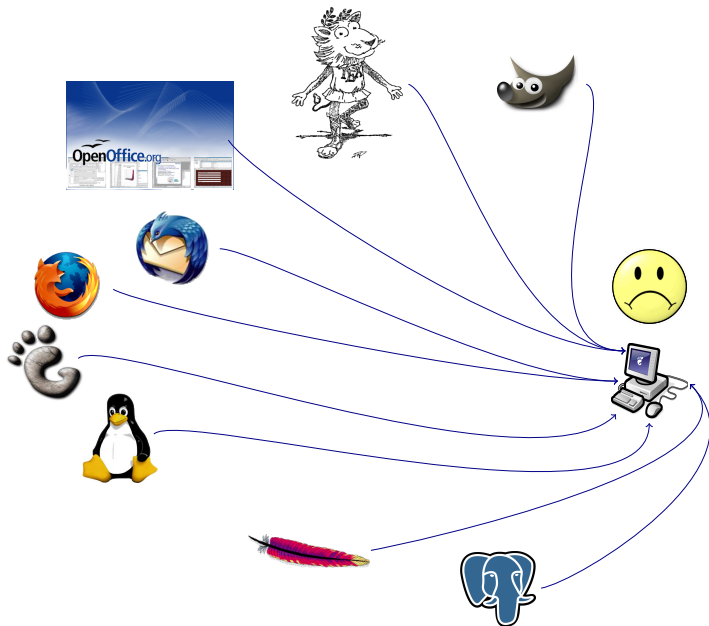

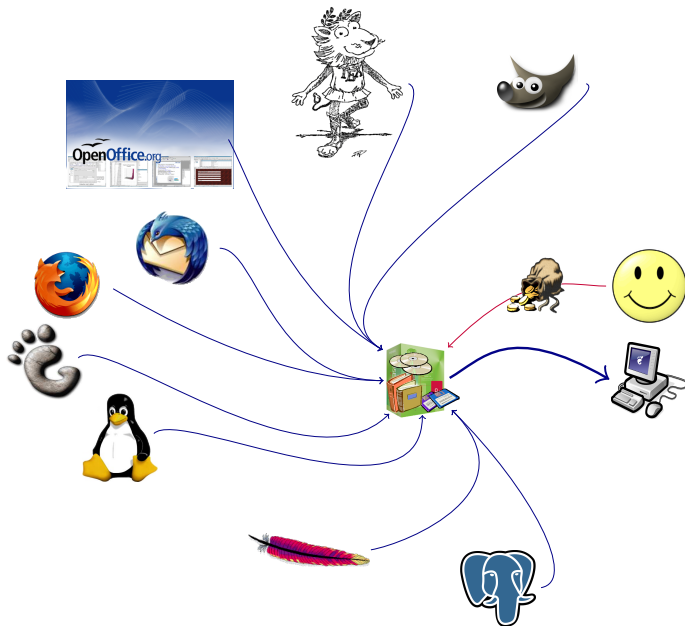

Linux from scratch



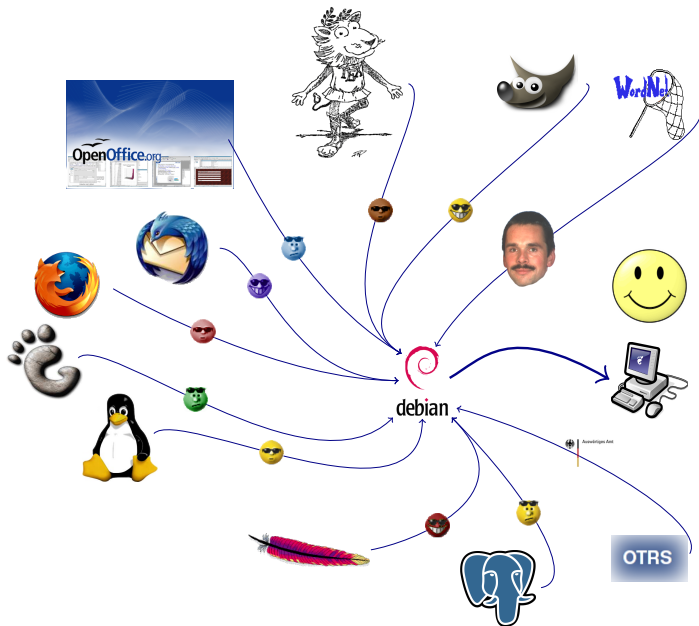
Distribution



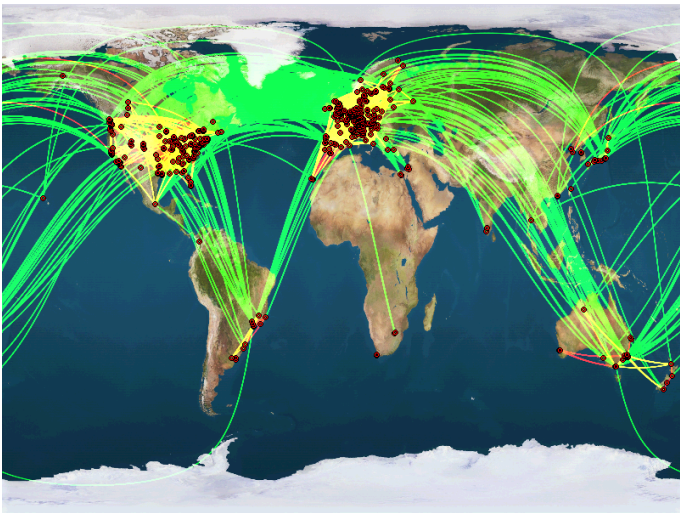
The missing link

- Distributor serves mass market
- Special software is missing (i.e. OTRS)
 - Solution: Many specialists build a distribution

Debian



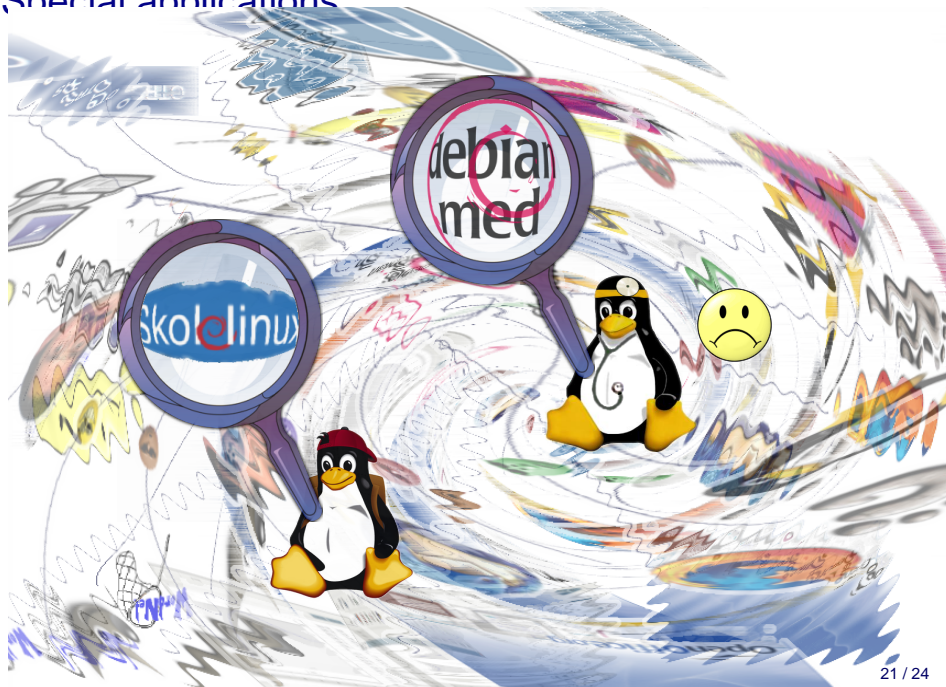
Web of trust



Specialists in the evolution

- Development of Free Software is evolutionary process
- Very successful in case of many users
- Special software has small user base
- Profile of the envisaged user:
 - Unreasonable effort to install upstream programs
 - No interest in administration
 - *Specific subset* of available free software
- Profile of administrators:
 - Limited time frame
 - Lack of specialist knowledge
